VOLUNTEERS

- May provide additional volunteers for bonus points (50 points each)

How to Indicate Participation
From your Administrator Dashboard, click Event Participation on the left-hand navigation menu. Press the "Yes" or "No" button for each event that you'd like to indicate your company's interest. You may change your answer as many times as necessary until the listed deadline.
